Questions you might see on the Final.

- 1. Find phonetic properties (see midterm). You will be provided with the IPA chart on the final.
- 2. Vocabulary: matching (see midterm)
- 3. Identify different alphabet types.
- 4. Identify roots, plus whether it is formed off of the past/present participle, or root (see midterm).
- 5. Given Latin or Greek structures, prefix(es) + root + various morphological pieces + suffixes, derive the English word or a nonsense word (see midterm). ex. ex + lig + e + t answer: elicit
- 6. Given an English word of Latin origin, come up the underlying structure by breaking it down into its morphological pieces (see Assignment #2).

 Example: convenient = con + ven + i (long 'i') + e + nt.
- 7. Given a French word, identify the process that has occurred.
- 8. Short answer (see Midterm).
- 9. Multiple choice: given a word, have to indicate which rules apply (see Assignment #2).
- 10. Germanic Consonant Shift (see Assignment #1 and Midterm)
