## INLP/FNEP COHORTS GRADUATION PROCEDURES FOR SUMMER 2024

### **Attention:** Indigenous Languages Program & Community Academic Outreach Cohort Students

#### ***Dear INLP/FNEP Student:***

If you are eligible to graduate from SFU after the completion of all of your academic requirements up to and including the current academic term: **SUMMER 2024**,

- or have missed the graduation application deadline for SPRING 2024; **and**

- you wish to participate in the SFU Convocation Ceremony in OCTOBER 2024 on Burnaby Campus,

**please note** the following additional graduation application details:

#### 1. Graduation application deadline(s):

**Early INLP Students Application Deadline: Monday, JUNE 10, 2024\*\***

\*\* If you missed the Early SUMMER 2024 graduation application deadline and the early graduation application period, you have until July 12, 2024 to submit your INLP Graduation Application to the INLP Office. (A late fee rate may apply.) **Please complete and submit your application to [inlp@sfu.ca](mailto:inlp@sfu.ca).**

2. Applicants must complete an Application for Graduation. **INLP students complete the INLP application.**

3. Download the application from the INLP Graduation webpage at [www.sfu.ca/inlp/graduation](http://www.sfu.ca/inlp/graduation)

4. All graduation applicants must remit a graduation application fee at the time of application to graduate. The Early graduation application fees are as follows:

(1) Early application fee for degree: \$35; (2) for certificate; (3) for diploma: \$20.

If the Early Application deadline is missed, FNEP students may be charged the final application fee:

(1) Final application fee for degree: \$85; (2) for certificate, \$70; (3) for diploma \$70.

If your graduation application fees will be provided by a sponsor, please ask your sponsor to complete the SFU Indigenous Student Sponsorship Authorization and forward to the Indigenous Languages Program office ([inlp@sfu.ca](mailto:inlp@sfu.ca)). 6. Please alert the Indigenous Languages Program Academic Advisor of your intention to apply to graduate or you have applied to graduate. **Email [inlp@sfu.ca](mailto:inlp@sfu.ca).**

7. The above information is specific to students in Indigenous Languages Program and students in Indigenous Community Academic Outreach Cohorts (FNEP, NEP, and SFU Kamloops).

8. The SFU Term Code: This four-digit number shows the century, year, and the term (Spring=1, SPRING=4, Fall=7). Term "1244" is comprised of the 2"1"st Century, the year 20"24", and the term code '4' for the SPRING Term. Term **1244**, read as 1-24-1, denotes the **SUMMER 2024** Academic Term.
