



SFU-SEG Student Chapter Field Trip Spring 2015: Mineral Deposits of South-Central British Columbia

Field Trip Objective:

The Simon Fraser University SEG-Student chapter field trip, scheduled for April 2015, aims to provide its members with a mineral deposit tour of two active mines and one exploration project in southern British Columbia. Students will be provided with a field trip guide providing geologic and economic information on each deposit from resource discovery to current stage exploitation. Additionally, the trip will include one lab tour, providing an introduction to geochemical assays and metallurgical testwork services. Finally, students will be given an opportunity to learn about local mining history in British Columbia and to network with industry professionals.
