

**Nechako Fisheries Conservation Program Independent Member:
Part-time contractual position**

The Nechako Fisheries Conservation Program Technical Committee (NFCP) is charged with the responsibility for conserving salmon resources of the Nechako River, BC, through implementation of an annual program of activities. This committee is made up of one Independent Member and technical representatives from Fisheries and Oceans Canada, the BC Ministry of Water, Land and Air Protection and Alcan Primary Metal – British Columbia.

Expressions of interest are being accepted for the position of Independent Member. The position of Independent Member requires a commitment of approximately 20 to 30 days per year. There are approximately 10 meetings per year; most of which are in Vancouver or Prince George, BC. The NFCP is undergoing a series of changes to adapt the existing program to current and expected future needs. The Independent Member will play a key role in that process. Strong facilitation and communication skills are required as well as previous experience with watershed or stewardship planning processes. A strong technical background in one or more of the general fields of freshwater fisheries, salmon biology, fish habitat, and hydrology is desirable. The position is for one year, renewable upon mutual consent of all parties.
