

Kuali Research: Finding Your Proposal

This document explains the different ways you can find your Proposals in Kuali Research, as they move through various stages of review and approval.

Once you have created and saved a proposal, it is assigned a number and will display in your Dashboard.

Once the proposal is approved, it is no longer visible on your Dashboard. You can find it in one of two places:

1. **Proposal Development** → **All My Proposals**. You can scroll through the proposals until you find the one you're looking for.
2. **Proposal Development** → **Search Proposals**. If you know the number of the proposal you're looking for, enter it in the field:

Alternatively, you can leave this field blank, and click **Search**. The results display all proposals, which is the same view as **All My Proposals**.

In both the **All My Proposals** and the **Search Proposals** views, all proposals you have submitted display, including the ones that have an **Approved** status. For approved proposals, click on **Medusa**:

to see the **Institutional Proposal** that was created when it was approved:

From both the **Proposal Development** views, or the **Institutional Proposal** view, you can click into the original proposal, and in **View Route Log**, you can see the names and dates of all the reviewers and approvers.

NOTE: The **All My Proposals** and **Search Proposals** views show proposals you have created in Kuali Research, which became active on March 20, 2024.

If you are looking for a proposal you submitted before that date, you can find it in **Institutional Proposals** → **Search Institutional Proposals**.

In this screen, if you know the proposal number, you must add an asterisk to the number for the result to display:

If you don't know the proposal number, it helps to enter some search parameters to narrow the search results, as all records from **1996** to **March 20, 2024** were migrated over.

From the **Proposal Type** drop-down menu, if you choose **New**, you will see only proposals you submitted in Kualu Research.

If you choose the **Migrated/Legacy (do not use)** option, this shows proposals that were migrated over from the legacy system, Grant Track.
