


Action: Camera pans down from sky to Ms. Wilson's house's front door. The figure of Ms. Wilson can be seen from outside.

Action: Ms. Wilson is sitting alone in her room holding a letter and looking at it with uncertainty. She does not read it and packs it into her purse.




Action: Ms. Wilson packs children's book into purse as well.

Action: Ms. Wilson exits the house and walks to the right, going off screen.




Action: Ms. Wilson quietly reads children's book, slowly pronouncing each letter and pointing. Camera moves to each word Ms. Wilson pronounces.

Dialog: Ms. Wilson - It's for my granddaughter. **Action:** Man sits beside Ms. Wilson gives a strange look at her.



Action: Ms. Wilson enters library entrance.

Action: Ms. Wilson looks at bookshelves. Camera pans quicky from left to right to express being overwhelmed.




Action: Ms. Wilson hides children's book with newspaper.

Action: Ms. Wilson pours empty vitamin bottle upside down with concerned face.



Action: Ms. Wilson looks at labels on vitamin bottles in confusion. Camera is slightly shaky ((hand helf effect) to convey weariness. **Action:** Woman walks near Ms. Wilson and looks for vitamins. Ms. Wilson holds glasses away from face and pretends to squint to imply she can't read because of bad eye sight.



Action: Ms. Wilson dumps 8 different vitamin bottles on the pharmacy counter.

Dialog: Ms. Wilson - As... they... cli-clim... (pause) climbed (sighs) **Action:** Suddenly drops book and holds head with both hands in frustration.



Dialog: Ms. Wilson (pause between each word) - "As they climbed, each little steam engh... engine began to sing: I-think-I-can! I-think-I-can!"


Action: Reads "The Little Engine That Could" and starts smiling.

Action: (Part of montage) Ms. Wilson takes book from bookshelf.



Action: Ms. Wilson closes children's book after finishes reading it fluently.

Action: Reads newspaper covering the book. Realizes she can read it fluently.



Dialog: "Dear Grandma, I love you sooo much. - Sarah" **Action:** Ms. Wilson reads grandchild's letter out loud. Action: Ms. Wilson smiles.
