<b>Post-mates</b>	Workers deliver dry cleaning, grocery, hot food, coffee, etc. using their car, truck, motorcycle or bicycle. Delivery people make 80% of the delivery fee and 100% of tips, with \$10 referrals for users and employees.
<b>Amazon Flex</b>	Delivering packages for Amazon can make delivery folks \$18-\$25 per hour. Amazon Flex lets folks set their schedule using the company's app & lets them make as many or few deliveries as they want seven days a week.
<b>Glovo</b>	Glovo is an on-demand service that purchases, picks-up and delivers anything that is ordered through the app. The service is carried out in less than an hour by independent couriers, called Glovers.
